



Manning Park Resort Boathouse Attendant

Do you have a passion for being out on the water? Are you familiar with a variety of watercraft? Do you enjoy sharing your knowledge and enthusiasm with others? Do you have experience working with money and the public? Would you like to spend the summer in a beautiful sub-alpine park? If you answered yes to those questions, being a Boathouse Attendant for Manning Park Resort is for you!

Job Requirements:

The successful applicants will be responsible for operating the Manning Park Resort Boathouse, renting out a variety of watercraft including canoes, kayaks, row boats and stand up paddleboards. They will have a high attention to detail in filling out rental forms and handling money. Boathouse Attendants will size guests for paddles and PFDs, assist guests in and out of watercraft, and provide basic instruction on the use of the watercraft. They will also be responsible for assisting to maintain the Lightning Lake Day Use Area grounds, and may be called upon to assist with special events or other park facility operations as needed.

Successful applicants will have a high degree of knowledge of a variety of watercraft. They will be self-motivated, responsible, and possess a valid driver's licence. They will have excellent verbal and written communication skills and have fantastic customer service skills. Certification or experience teaching canoeing, kayaking or stand up paddle boarding is beneficial, as is experience in boat rescue. They will also have excellent multitasking and cash handling skills. Applicants must be fit and able to launch and store watercraft repeatedly throughout the day.

Accommodations:

Accommodation is available in the Manning Park Resort staff housing community for a reasonable utilities fee. Other options may be available in the nearby communities of Eastgate, Sunshine Valley or Hope.

Wages:

Wages will be between \$13.85 and \$14.00 per hour depending on skills and experience. The position will involve up to 40 hours of work per week, including weekends. The position will start for the May long weekend and go until Labour Day.
